Five SBA Disaster Assistance Centers in New York to Close Dec. 8 *Over \$100 Million in SBA Disaster Loans Approved*

ATLANTA – The U.S. Small Business Administration announced today that due to a steady decrease of activity, four Disaster Loan Outreach Centers (DLOCs) and one Business Recovery Center (BRC) located in New York will cease operations on **Thursday, Dec. 8** at 12 noon.

The Small Business Administration urges those affected by Hurricane Irene or Tropical Storm Lee to visit these Centers before they close to obtain one-on-one assistance and information about the disaster assistance program. The SBA also encourages homeowners, renters and businesses who received applications to return their completed applications as quickly as possible.

The SBA has approved over **\$100 million** in Disaster Assistance Loans for residents and business owners in **New York**. “Currently, **2,311** home and business disaster loans have been approved in the amount of **\$102,280,000** for affected survivors,” said Frank Skaggs, director of SBA’s Field Operations Center East in Atlanta. “We are pleased to be able to get these loans approved so residents and businesses in the disaster area can start to rebuild and resume their normal lives.”

The deadline to return SBA applications for physical property damage for Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee is **December 15, 2011**. The deadline to return applications for economic injury is **May 31, 2012** for Hurricane Irene and **June 13, 2012** for Tropical Storm Lee.
